Will be received at the Department of Accounting and General Services, Public Works Division Office, fourth floor of the Kalanimoku Building, Room 426, 1151 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawai'i. Bidders are advised to access the solicitation documents via our website at <http://publicworks.hawaii.gov/bidding/>.

Submit the Competitive SOLICITATION, OFFER AND CONTRACT FORM up to 2:00 PM, on Thursday July 2, 2026. At that time, bids will be publicly opened. Bids received after the due time and date will not be considered.

The work generally consists of demolition and replacement of perimeter security fencing and related improvements at Halawa Correctional Facility (HCF). The scope includes replacement of single-, double-, and triple-row perimeter fencing. New perimeter fencing will include inner and outer fence lines with posts, concrete foundations, anti-climb features, razor ribbon, barbed wire outriggers, concrete mow strips or anti-dig barriers, lighting, and door controls. Work also includes replacement and installation of vehicle and pedestrian sallyport gates, swing, sliding, and man gates. New work includes construction of a vehicle sallyport at the southeast portion of the facility. Work includes Civil, Structural, and Electrical.

The estimated construction cost is over \$10 million.

All interested parties are invited to attend a voluntary pre-bid meeting and the State conducted site visit. No other time for a site inspection will be scheduled or allowed.

The pre-bid meeting and the accompanying State conducted site visit will be held at: Halawa Correctional Facility, 99-902 Moanalua Road, Aiea, HI 96701, Wednesday, May 27, 2026, at 9:00 AM. The site visit will immediately follow the meeting.

Bidders shall comply with all access requirements of the facility or the User Agency. Each Bidder shall bring their own flashlight and small tools that may be required to inspect the premises. Bidders and interested parties are required to sign-in at the meetings to confirm attendance. Check with Project Coordinator.

The estimated value of the public works contract is \$250,000 or more and the apprenticeship agreement preference pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes §103-55.6 (ACT 17, SLH 2009) shall apply.

Campaign Contributions by State and County Contractors Prohibited.

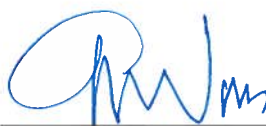
If awarded a contract in response to this solicitation, offeror agrees to comply with HRS section 11-355, which states that campaign contributions are prohibited from a State and County government contractor during the term of the contract if the contractor is paid with funds appropriated by the legislative body, at any time between the execution of the contract through the completion of the contract.

Project Labor Agreement.

In accordance with the Administrative Directive No. 24-01 (Directive), dated February 16, 2024, Project Labor Agreement for State Construction Projects; and COMPTROLLER'S MEMORANDUM NO. 2024-20, Guidelines - Project Labor Agreements (PLA) for State Construction Projects, dated July 26, 2024, a PLA is required for projects with actual award amounts in excess of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000). Refer to specification SECTION 00210 - INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS for Project Labor Agreement requirements.

To be eligible to submit a Bid, the Bidder must possess valid State of Hawai'i Contractor's license classifications B.
