

CA DMV RFQ # ISD26-3958 Questions and Answers:

- 1. Q.** Could you let me know what the California DMV is currently using for its Unified Endpoint Management (UEM) environment?

A. This RFQ is for renewal of software already in use by DMV. All part numbers and quantities have been confirmed. The UEM environment information is not required for this renewal.
- 2. Q.** The Key Action Dates identify June 21, 2026, as the date for DMV responses to written questions. Please confirm whether the intended date is July 21, 2026.

A. The Key Action Date for DMV responses to written questions is July 21, 2026.
- 3. Q.** Must the prime bidder be a Broadcom-authorized reseller or include a Broadcom or distributor authorization letter with its quote?

A. An authorization letter is not one of the RFQ requirements. The awarded Bidder must be able to fulfill the software renewal as specified.
- 4. Q.** If the bidder purchases the specified renewal through an authorized Broadcom distributor, must that distributor be identified as a subcontractor on the Bidder Declaration, GSPD-05-105?

A. No, the distributor is not identified as a subcontractor on the Bidder Declaration, GSPD-05-105.
- 5. Q.** Please confirm that the quoted renewal must preserve uninterrupted licensing from July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, regardless of the purchase-order award date, and must include all applicable reinstatement, prorated, and true-up fees.

- 6. Q.** Please confirm that award will be based on the lowest evaluated cost from a responsive and responsible bidder, after application of any validated preferences or incentives.
