Performance and/or Design Requirements (intended use, function or application, compatibility etc. requirements; reference to policy, rule, statute or other act of the Legislature, etc., as appropriate): The Florida Department of Transportation (Department), Office of Information Systems, requires specialized software to support transportation design, inspection, and project management functions. The Department currently utilizes comprehensive software provided through AASHTOWare, which is developed by and specifically for transportation agencies. The AASHTOWare Bridge Management software supports the entire bridge management cycle, including inspection, maintenance tracking, program optimization, federal reporting, and assessment of performance measures. The software integrates agency specific objectives of public safety, risk reduction, user convenience, and investment preservation to produce optimized budgetary, maintenance, and program policies. It provides a systematic procedure for the allocation of resources to the preservation and improvement of bridges in a network, by considering the life-cycle costs and benefits of maintenance policies versus investments in improvements or replacements. As a web-based application, AASHTOWare Bridge Management supports asset management through a web server either hosted on an agency's server or hosted remotely through hosting services. These hosting services are needed to get Department software updated to meet federal requirements that must be completed by December 2026. Increasing the level of support ensures the Department is compliant with Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) requirements for submission of Specifications for the National Bridge Inventory (SNBI) files.

Intended source (vendor, contractor): AASHTO

Estimated Dollar Amount: \$212,896.00

Justification for single source acquisition (what is necessary and unique about the product, service or source; steps taken to confirm unavailability of competition, as appropriate): AASHTO is the only known source capable of providing this proprietary software suite and its associated maintenance and support services. There are no other vendors or authorized distributors of AASHTOWare products, and no other known vendors can perform maintenance on this system. The Department has determined that no alternative software solutions provide the same level of functionality, integration, and effectiveness for transportation design, inspection, and project management. As such, AASHTO is uniquely qualified to meet the Department's operational requirements.
