The RFP package has been revised with Addendum 1. The following revisions have been made to the RFP:

- RFP Attachment 14: Proposer Qualifications Form, Requirement 1 has been revised as follows:

Requirement Number	Classification	Qualifications
1.	Mandatory (M)	Experience with the implementation of two (2) projects involving IT systems for a public entity or agency, at least one (1) of which was the implementation of an enterprise billing system. Each of the two (2) projects must have occurred within the last ten (10) years.

- RFP Attachment 23: Appendix A, Statement of Work Section 4, License Type has been revised as follows:

If the Contractor's SaaS solution includes licenses, the State reserves the right to continue use of the solution after the conclusion of this Contract by obtaining licenses through other State-authorized contracting vehicles.

The solution shall be non-proprietary and shall not impose limitations restricting the State's ability to procure licenses or maintenance outside of this Contract, including through potential Software Licensing Program (SLP) agreements if available. Use of an SLP is optional and not required.

All configurations, customizations, integrations, interfaces, reports, workflows, and other derivative works created for the State and funded by the State during the term of the Contract shall be owned by the State. This clause supersedes any conflicting provisions in PD 402 ITGP or in the Contractor's SaaS license terms. The Contractor shall provide all State-owned derivative works and related documentation to the State in an industry standard format upon Contract

conclusion.

Proposers are advised to review the updated language included in this Addendum. All other terms and conditions of the RFP shall remain the same.
